We are in receipt of your letter of the 9th inst., and we note contents. This vessel is due in Hartlepool over the weekend, and our Marine Superintendents will be in touch with your Newcastle Office in regard to the completion of the work necessary to finish her Special Survey.

The Writer is particularly disappointed, however, to note what you say in regard to White Sea Trading, and we are sure both Mr. Sladden and Mr. Turnbull will remember that we have always made a special point of White Sea Trading for this vessel, and we were given to understand that there would be no difficulty in this requirement. The vessel was built for the timber trade, and she is strengthened for ice, and we feel that it is essential that we should have the trading limits to include this requirement.


During our discussions with you in London this restriction was never mentioned, and we must point out to you that you then agreed that we would have full European Trading Limits. We, therefore, do ask you to review this point forthwith so that we can discuss same further with our London Partners, Messrs. Harris & Dixon Ltd.
