Dear Sirs,

I beg to acquaint you that careful consideration has been given to the suggestions made in your letter of the 2nd instant for an extension of the service limits in the case of the steamer "OAKLEY".

In reply, it is regretted that approval cannot be given for her to operate north of 69°N., round the North Cape and into the White Sea, and that the maximum limits possible are those given in my letter of the 21st ultimo.

It is noted from the last paragraph of your letter that the outstanding items of classification will be completed in the near future, and on receipt of the Surveyors' reports thereon, the ship will be recommended to the Committee for that restricted classification.
