I duly received your letter of the 4th instant respecting the Steamer "OAKLEY", the contents of which are noted.

The trading limits and the question of the relative service notation have now been considered and the following description for Register Book notation, based on your proposal, has been formulated:-

"For service between European and African ports between 12°N. and 69°N.; also between ports in East Africa North of 30°S., India, Malaya, China and Japan."

It is considered that the above covers much the same area as your proposal but defines the actual limits more precisely, and I therefore trust that this will meet with your approval.
