

Extract from letter addressed to Hong Kong
Surveyors on 19th September, 1949.

Dear Sirs,

With reference to the final paragraph of your letter of the 12th ultimo respecting the Steamer "AN LIEN", I set forth below the position regarding overdue surveys of certain Chinese vessels and shall be obliged if you will let me know in due course what arrangements are made for these inspections to be carried out.

"HWAH SUNG"

Classification Survey partly held at Shanghai 11.48. Validity of notation "Examined 11.48" will expire at end of November next. Validity of Load Line Certificate expires 30.11.49 and a Renewal Survey will require to be held in conjunction with the completion of the Special Survey. To complete the Classification Survey please see enclosed statement.

I would refer you to your report No.9631 on this case.

"NAN SHENG"

The greater part of a Reclassification Survey was held at Shanghai in October/November 1948. The validity of the notation "Examined 11.48" will expire at the end of November next. The validity of the Load Line Certificate expires 30.11.49 and a Renewal Survey will require to be held in conjunction with the completion of the Special Survey. The shell drillings have been approved. To complete the Reclassification Survey as regards the hull, please see attached statement. All the machinery requirements have been complied with.
