Steamer "EMPIRE FAUN" temporarily sailing

Reverting to the telephone conversations which took place between us last June, I write to inform you that the Society's Surveyors at Piraeus have on several occasions requested the Greek Ministry Authorities to state what arrangements are proposed for the inspection of the repairs which were recommended to be effected to this ship in June, 1960, but that the necessary information is not forthcoming.

In the circumstances, the Committee of this Society who have had the case under consideration today have decided to expunge the vessel's class owing to reported defects and our Piraeus Surveyors are being requested to inform the Greek Ministry of the position.
