"EMPIRE FAUN" temporarily sailing as "SIRIUS"

Further to our letter of the 7th instant in reply to yours of 26th May regarding above vessel we have received a letter from Ministry of Marine which states:-

"We have to inform you that the repairs of the "SIRIUS" have been carried out and now the vessel is trading".

This vessel was surveyed at Suda Bay, Crete, on 30th May and 15th and 16th June, 1960 for Docking, Special Survey (Dr.), Engine Survey, Main Boiler and Screw Shaft Surveys.

Repairs were recommended, both hull and machinery and the Screw shaft was also condemned.

The recommended repairs to the vessel were confirmed in a letter to the Ministry of Marine, Naval Base, Salamis, on the 1st July, 1960.

Letters dated 27th August, 19th September, 6th October, 13th December, 1960 and on the 13th April, 1961 were sent to the Ministry of Marine, General Staff reminding them that the Special Survey etc. was still not completed but no replies were received until the letter quoted above.

It is suggested that the Owners (Ministry of Transport) should be approached regarding completion of the surveys.
