Dear Sirs,

Steamer "LUEN HWA"

I am obliged to you for your cablegram of the 22nd June and have since enquired of the Singapore Surveyors as to what arrangements are being made for the overdue Special Survey. They have replied that the Charterers have confirmed the vessel is trading in Indonesian waters and that they will cable the ship to return to Singapore as soon as possible.

The Committee have had the case before them today and have commented on the fact that they have already agreed to a postponement of five months beyond the year of grace, which expired last January, and they consider that the overdue Special Survey should be put in hand at a very early date.

They have, therefore, instructed me to cable to you that unless the vessel sails from an Indonesian port within ten days direct to a Far East port for Special Survey on arrival, they will have seriously to consider whether further maintenance of class is justified. I have, therefore, cabled to you and to Singapore as per copies herewith.

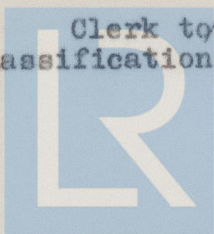
I am asking the Singapore Surveyors to keep me advised of any developments.
