Dear Sirs,

I have to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them at their meeting today a first entry report on the steel screw barge "HAUER", built at Salt Bommel by Messrs. J. Mappet's Shipbuilding Co.,

In forwarding their report the Rotterdam Surveyors state that through an error the working pressure of the boiler was taken as 140 lb. instead of 127 lb. per square inch, and in the circumstances a record of L.M.C. 8,26 has been assigned subject to the valves being adjusted to a working pressure of 127 lb.


It is understood that the vessel is proceeding to Southampton and I have to request that you will give the above matter the necessary attention and report thereon in due course.
