I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 31st ultimo, the contents of which have been noted.

The suggestion that the machinery of this vessel should be regarded as coming under the Continuous Survey arrangement is concurred in, having regard to the arrangement previously made between the British Corporation and the Owners, and on this basis the outstanding items requiring examination are as follows:-

Nos. 1, 2 and 4 main crankshaft journals, ✓  
Thrust and intermediate shafts, ✓  
Condenser, Ballast pump, ✓  
Pumping arrangements, ✓  
Electrical equipment.

I shall therefore be glad if you will approach the Owners with a view to obtaining their agreement to the case being dealt with in this manner and inform them that if the above mentioned remaining parts can be examined at the next Annual Survey, it will be possible to assign a notation of MBS\* 5,51.

I shall therefore be glad to learn the result of your discussion with the Owners.
