I have to refer to your letter of the 4th and mine of the 19th of April 1950 respecting continuance of this vessel's class by Annual Surveys.

It is noted that an Annual Survey has been held, and that a notation of MESE 5,51 has been assigned on the machinery. Such record implies that all requirements of the Rules have been complied with whereas reference to the report indicates that this is not the case, nor can the vessel be regarded as being entitled to a Continuous Survey record, as the whole of the machinery has not been examined during the last 4 years.

It would therefore appear that the vessel is only entitled to the record of Annual Survey 5,51, covering both hull and machinery, but I shall be glad to receive your comments on this point.
