By special arrangement this ship undergoes Annual Surveys in lieu of Special Surveys.

An Annual Survey has now been held, but the Liverpool Committee have assigned a record of MBS* 5,51. Such a record implies that all the requirements of the Rules have been complied with. According to the report however, this is not the case, nor can the vessel be regarded as 'being' entitled to a CS record as the whole of the machinery has not been examined during the last four years.

It would therefore seem that the records to be assigned should be "Annual Survey 5,51, Blr.S 5,51 and msp 4,51".

The Liverpool Surveyors should however, be asked for their comments.
