We were informed by the Trieste Surveyors as long ago as Jan. 1946 that plans of the M/T. "CARNARO" had been submitted and a class recommended.

The vessel is now under survey at this port for damage, during the course of repairs both hull and machinery have been examined throughout, and the vessel would be eligible for the records of Special Survey, LMC, and Screw shaft seen, on completion in a few weeks time.

In view however, of the notation in the Register Book "Class Contemplated" would you please inform us if this class has now been assigned, and if not, what should be the nature of the surveys held by us.
