Repairs to the M/T "CARNARO".

As you probably know our M/T "CARNARO" had her stern & poop structures damaged through enemy action in March 1943. She was subsequently sunk in Naples Harbour through mine explosions.

The vessel has now been salvaged and towed to the Cantieri della Navalmeccanica, Castellamare di Stabia, for repairs. The contractors have undertaken to reinstate the vessel in the same conditions she was as before sustaining the damage, to the inspection of L.R. Surveyors with a view to obtaining the highest class for this type of vessel.

Messrs. FIAT will overhaul the Machinery and shafting under the same conditions.

We are therefore requesting you to undertake the survey in question and have to confirm that all fees and expenses in connection thereto will be chargeable directly to us.


