Dear Sir,

We have to acknowledge receipt of your letter "S" of the 11th instant regarding the case of the steamer "OILFIELD", and the contents of your letter of the same date addressed to the Owners are noted.

We have to inform you that a General Examination of the vessel was carried out yesterday while lying afloat at Dunston, and the Windlass, Steering Gear and the Steam Capstans used as secondary means of steering were all tried under steam and found satisfactory.

An examination equivalent to a Freeboard Annual Survey was also carried out with a view to the issue of a provisional Freeboard Certificate to cover the voyage from the Tyne to Holland, and some minor repairs recommended are now in hand.

Arrangements are also being made for an internal examination of the donkey boiler and the vessel is expected to leave about the middle of next week.
