With reference to the classification of the tanker "CAMPALANS", the Vigo Surveyor, writing on the 9th instant, stated that the local Campsa Office are awaiting instructions from their Madrid Office regarding the drydocking and outstanding surveys, and as no facilities are locally available she may go to Cadiz.

As you are perhaps aware the vessel has been used as a depot ship for oil bunkering purposes at Vigo for some time past, but as she has not been seen in dry dock since May 1953 the Committee must ask for her to be inspected in drydock by the Society's Surveyors not later than the end of May next if she is to retain her class.

The Boiler Survey also became due in January and doubtless you will be able to arrange for both these inspections to be held by that time.
