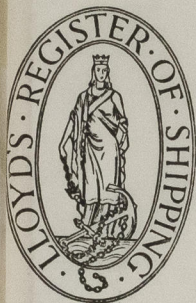

"MONTMOREAU" 10706 tons gross of Dunkirk whilst the ship was lying afloat at Port de Bouc, France, after the ship had made the passage in tow from Gibraltar to Port de Bouc, with a view to ascertaining if the said ship was in a fit condition to be towed as a hulk from Port de Bouc to Bilbao where she is to be broken up.

The temporary repairs and arrangements carried out in Gibraltar in December 1961 have been examined and this ship as now seen is considered to be in a fit condition to be towed as a hulk from Port de Bouc to Bilbao.

This certificate is limited to the condition of the aft section of the ship and does not carry any responsibility for the towing arrangements.
