MACHINERY INTERIM CERTIFICATE.

This is to Certify that

K. Eriksson,

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of Messrs. A/B Gävle Varv, Gävle, the Builders of the Twin Screw Motor Salvage Ship "ARBAN" (Yard No. 102) of Leningrad, attend onboard during the installation of the machinery at the Builders' Yard.

The machinery has been installed under Special Survey in conformity with the Society's Rules and Regulations, and this is to certify that, on completion of the installation, a report will be transmitted to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, recommending that the machinery be classed:-

+LMC (Lloyd's Machinery Certificate) 11.59

with the notations of "Tailshaft (Continuous Liner)" and "Strengthened for Navigation in Ice", the engines not to be operated continuously between 80 and 100 r.p.m.
