I acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 14th instant and note the request now made by the Owners.

In reply, it is considered they should be informed that for classification it is necessary for both the hull and the machinery to be examined in accordance with our Rules; but that it will be quite in order for Load Line Surveys to be held on these vessels as unclassified ships. This will mean, of course, that the hulls will periodically require to be examined as for Special Survey, and if it is likely to be of any help to the Owners, our Surveyors will be authorised to issue a certificate which will be confined to statements of fact in regard to the parts actually seen and their condition as found.
