Steam Tanker "INVERRUBA"

I acknowledge the receipt of your cablegram of yesterday's date and in confirmation of my cabled reply today, as per copy herewith, I would inform you that as this vessel is so long overdue for Special Survey the Committee could not agree to her performing the proposed voyage as a classed ship, but that in order to help the Owners as far as practicable the Committee would not object to a Certificate being issued as an unclassed vessel, provided suitable safeguards are fulfilled to ensure her efficiency. To this end it is considered a General Examination should be held on both hull and machinery and that the Main Boiler Survey, started at Trinidad last July, should be completed, the boiler pressure not to exceed 160 lb. per square inch until satisfactory repairs have been effected to the furnaces.


