Dear Sirs,

With reference to the steel screw steamer No. 196 proposed to be built by you, I beg to inform you that the main bulb angle frames in way of the upper deck and in the peaks will be approved as proposed. The bulb angle frames in way of the raised quarter deck, including the engine and boiler space, should be 9" x 3½" x .66", spaced 27".

In the circumstances I have had pleasure in wiring you this morning, as follows, viz:-

"Steamer 196 scantlings main frames in way upper deck
"and peaks approved frames in way raised deck and engine
"boiler space should be nine 3½ 66 bulb angle spaced 27".
