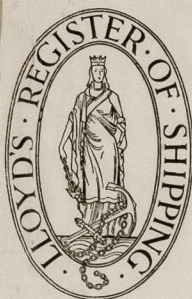

Upon examination in dry dock, no damage was found to be attributable to the alleged casualty.
