Steamer "MONTE SAJA"

A report has been received from the Surveyors at Antwerp in respect of a survey carried out in December last, from which it is noted that a General Examination, with a view to a postponement of the Special Survey being granted, was carried out in drydock.

As a result of this inspection, the Committee have agreed to the Special Survey being deferred until December, 1957.

The class of the ship has now been continued with a fresh record of Drydocking 12,56, subject to indented keel and shell plating, amidships and starboard side forward, being further examined at the next drydocking and dealt with by the Special Survey, to the stern post below the aperture, which was electrically welded and reinforced in July, 1955, being specially examined at the next drydocking, and to the after peak tank top, which was found to be wasted, being specially examined and dealt with as necessary at the next Special Survey.

Concerning the machinery, the class is subject to the cone taper of the screwshaft being again examined by the end of December, 1957, and to the main cables from the switchboard aft through the 'tween decks, being renewed as necessary by the next Special Survey.

I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners accordingly.
