Steamer "ARGOBEC"

I have to acquaint you that the request contained in your letter of the 29th August has been considered by the Committee today, and in confirmation of my telephone message this afternoon, I am to point out that the Screwshaft Survey of this Liberty type ship became due so long ago as May, 1958, and in these circumstances the Committee must ask that this inspection be carried out before the ship leaves Rotterdam.

This will, of course, necessitate drydocking and in addition to the Main Boiler Survey, which it is noted the Owners intend holding, the Committee will require a General Examination for postponement of the Special Survey, which became due at the end of May last.

I am to suggest that as the ship is to drydock before leaving Rotterdam, you take the opportunity to have the bottom etc., examined as for Special Survey and thus avoid further drydocking when the Special Survey is completed after unloading at a Mediterranean port.
