
We would add that direct reading thermometers have been fitted in addition to the electric thermometers.

We regret the omission of the above in our original submissions.

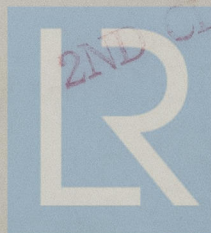
