Motorship "SANTA CECILIA"

I am in receipt of your cablegram of the 2nd October and note that you have been unable to obtain from the Owners any reply to your enquiry regarding the Special Survey.

The case has been reported to the Committee today and they desire me to say that in view of the ship's age they are not prepared to allow this matter to be deferred indefinitely, and have given instructions for the class to be suspended pending the receipt of a definite proposal from the Owners and a notation of "Surveys overdue - class suspended 10.63" will be entered in the Register Book.

It is also noted that the ship may revert to B.V. classification and you should continue to press the Owners for a definite statement as to their intentions regarding the ship's future.
