Dear Mr. Sladden,

m.s. "BLENDA".

I have received your letter of the 6th instant regarding the "BLENDA" and have carefully noted your comments as regards the cases where the Committee's decision forbidding the record of a "Rebuilt" notation in the Register Book are applicable.

Since January, 1950, when you suggested the record "Rebuilt (with date) excepting frames, sternframe and keel (iron) built 1855" the following alteration has taken place, viz. the stern frame has been renewed and consequently the record should be:-

"Rebuilt (with date) excepting frames and keel (iron) built 1875"

The date of build is namely 1875 and not 1855 as was wrongly stated in a Gothenburg letter of the 7th December, 1946, to the Secretary.

I have discussed the matter with the Owners who have expressed their agreement with the suggested record.

I have pleasure in acknowledging the receipt of your letter of the 10th Dec 1911, in relation to the proposed alterations to the Rules of the Society.

The Committee have considered the proposals and have decided to recommend that the alterations should be adopted.

The following alterations are proposed to be adopted:

1. The word "shall" shall be substituted for "may" in Rule 10.

2. The word "may" shall be substituted for "shall" in Rule 11.

3. The word "shall" shall be substituted for "may" in Rule 12.

4. The word "shall" shall be substituted for "may" in Rule 13.

5. The word "shall" shall be substituted for "may" in Rule 14.

6. The word "shall" shall be substituted for "may" in Rule 15.

7. The word "shall" shall be substituted for "may" in Rule 16.

8. The word "shall" shall be substituted for "may" in Rule 17.
