Coal bunker hatch on casing top now removed and opening plated over with 3 oil tight access manholes to oil fuel bunkers. 3 - 6" dia. air pipes, 30" high coaming fitted on casing top for oil fuel bunkers and 1 - 2½" dia. air pipe, 36" high coaming fitted on raised quarter deck (port side) for diesel oil tank.

Air pipes fitted with flashproof gauzes and provided with canvas covers. ✓
