The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

The class is subject to bottom shell plating in way of Nos. 3, 4 & 5 D.B. tanks, shell plate C.1 (p.s.f.), rudder, and indented side shell plating (p & s), etc. being specially examined and dealt with as necessary by next Special Survey (~~now~~ due 5,54).

SPECIAL SURVEY (C) became due 5,54.

The OS LO Surveyors who were authorised (refer letter dated 16.7.54) report 7,54, this ship generally examined afloat with a view to her proceeding to an Italian port, probably La Spezia, at which time the Special Survey and conversion of ship into a dry cargo ship is to be carried out.

IT IS SUBMITTED ACTION be DEFERRED for Special Survey, subject as above.
