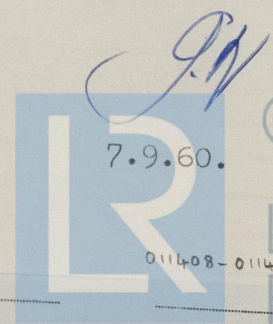

The Surveyor reports the lower section of the centre furnace of the after boiler found locally thin and the furnace cropped and satisfactorily renewed in way of wastage.

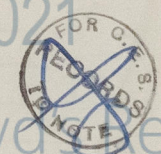
