The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

This ship was originally built to class BS* with the British Corporation in October 1934. The class lapsed when the ship was on war service with the Royal Australian Navy due to non-compliance with Survey requirements.

The Owners now desire Reclassification with the British Corporation and a Special Survey for this purpose, including drydocking, drillings and Annual Load Line Survey, has been carried out by the non-exclusive Surveyors to the British Corporation at SYDNEY, N.S.W. See B.C. Report dated June 20th, 1949.

The anchor and cable equipment on board is as originally fitted and approved.

In accordance with normal British Corporation practice a confirmatory Survey by an exclusive Surveyor will be required, and a letter from 'S' Dept., London, dated August 15th instructs the Sydney Surveyors regarding the Survey.

IT IS SUBMITTED the vessel is eligible to be reclassified BS* WHEN a report on a satisfactory confirmatory survey by an exclusive Surveyor has been received, and when a reply is received to B.C. letter of August 11th 1949, requesting confirmation that no alterations were carried out to hull or machinery during the vessel's war service, with fresh record of docking 6.49 and to have the notation of 'ss 12.48' and 'Annual Survey 12.48'
