I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 28th September, the contents of which have been noted.

A copy of the sale agreement is being sent to the Society's Surveyors at Antwerp and Rotterdam today as it is not clear from your letter whether this has been sent to them,

Their particular attention is being drawn to clauses 6, 16 and 19 but, with regard to clause 19, I would point out that maintenance of machinery spare gear is not a condition of class and it is concluded that you will inform the Purchasers accordingly.

The present position in regard to the Continuous Survey of Machinery is as follows and the date recorded against the items is the date on which the various parts became or will become due for survey:-

Main engine No.3 side and centrd crankpins and bearings - February 1965.

No.1 cylinder, piston, rod, valves and gears and No.1 side and centre crankpins and bearings - September 1965.

Main engine driven FW cooling and lubricating oil pumps - November 1965.
