In reply to your letter of the 1st April I have to say that provided a satisfactory General Examination is held in drydock not later than the end of November, 1964, and the long overdue Screwshaft Survey then be held, the Committee will be prepared to consider the postponement of the Special Survey. In view of the age of the vessel the period of postponement granted will, however, be dependent upon the condition as found and reported upon at the General Examination.


It is concluded that the Main Boiler Survey, due at the end of July next, will be dealt with at the drydocking, when the Continuous Survey cycle of the machinery should be completed or, alternatively, a General Examination of the machinery be made in accordance with Circular 1959.

As requested, I enclose a list of the items outstanding to complete the Continuous Survey cycle of the machinery, and shall be glad if you will advise the Owners accordingly.
