

Messrs. S.A. Enchimar, Owners of the above vessels have requested to be informed of the surveys due dates of the above vessels, also of the exact position of the continuous survey of the machinery.

They state that the " CINDERELLA " is now under survey at Durban and they have given instructions for the following items to be examined at this time, viz:-

- 3 connecting rod bottom ends, centrally and laterally of cylinder N°.4
- N°.5 crank shaft bearing
- Fresh water cooler
- Auxiliary condenser

They propose to dry dock this vessel between July and November 1964 and carry out a General Examination with a view to postponing the Special Survey due in January 1965 until January 1966. The tailshaft survey will also be carried out during this drydocking.

As regards the "CAROLINA" they propose to drydock the vessel early in 1965 to carry out a General Examination in order to postpone the Special Survey until February 1966. The tailshaft survey will also be carried out during this drydocking.
