I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 28th February returning your Rpt. 9 No. 8666.

It is noted that you include the condenser doors with the items remaining to be dealt with for completion of the Special Survey. As, however, you have examined the doors, found them to be defective and are of the opinion that they should be renewed, then a condition of class should be recorded with the recommendation that the doors be renewed by a certain time. Please let me know by return the date or occasion by which you consider this renewal should be carried out.

The fact that the repairs may in the meantime have been carried out does not affect the issue as the condition of class to be recorded will not be deleted until the Society's Surveyors have ascertained that satisfactory repairs have been effected.
