It is noted that the machinery numeral recorded in the Register Book in the case of the above mentioned ship is 643. This figure is based on a saturated drum pressure of 250 lbs., whereas the figure should be 628, based on the superheat pressure of 230 lbs.

Our attention was drawn to this matter in the case of previous 'Victory' Type Ships, per your letter of the 2nd February, 1944, referring to the case of the Steamer "FORT COLUMBIA". - *Built 1943-7 mo.*
