Motorship "TILIA GORTHON" now

A report has been received from the Algiers Surveyor of a survey held in January, from which it is noted No. 6 hold was examined on account of damage stated to have been caused by fire.

As a result of this inspection the class of the ship has been made subject to shell and deck plating and internal structure in way of No. 6 hold (fire damage) being further examined and dealt with as necessary on arrival at Rostock, to which Port the ship is now proceeding.

I shall be glad if you will ascertain from the new Owners, Messrs. V.E.B. Deutsche Seereederei, of Rostock, and advise this Office, whether these repairs are now receiving attention under the inspection of the Society's Surveyors, and, if not, what arrangements they propose to make in this respect.
