Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines

Small hatch on forecastle deck to forecastle space below 18" diameter  
coaming 15" x .30" with steel hinged lid secured by <sup>waterlight</sup> toggles and wing nuts. ✓

Skylight on poop deck to galley below strongly constructed with steel  
coaming 30" high and hinged steel flaps. ✓

Side scuttles are fitted in poop side plating to accommodation in poop  
space, scuttles of substantial construction with hinged deadlights. ✓

3" air pipe in forecastle space to fore peak tank G.H. pipe 36" high with  
opening 30" above deck. ✓

2 @ 3" diameter pipe scuppers at after end of upper deck scuppers led through  
shell below deck. ✓
