With reference to the First Entry Certificates which were sent to you on the 6th March last, the Owners' London Agents have telephoned that they do not desire such certificates to be issued until the ship enters commission.

The position as set out in my letter to you of the 29th October last has been explained to the Owners' Agents, and they quite understand that there is no question of amending the date of build, with the exception of a launched and commissioned date being assigned later.

Messrs. Andreadis (U.K.) Ltd. have been informed that if the Builders are prepared to return to this Office the First Entry Certificates and copies already issued, they will be cancelled and fresh certificates will be issued at a later date when the ship enters commission.
