*and that I am transmitting to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I am recommending that she be continued as classed with fresh record of D.S. 6,64, subject to one bower anchor being supplied at the earliest opportunity and to 3 links out of every 5 length of cable supplied at Hong Kong (6,64,) being subjected to satisfactory statutory breaking test, but without condition regards to the bilge plate in way of No.1 hold, to the starboard anchor being tested and to 30 fathoms of chain cable being supplied.*
