Mr Carpenter of Messrs. Furness, Withy & Co, Ld., informed me in reply to an enquiry which I addressed to him, that this steamer like her sister ship the "HELIKON", should be recorded in the Register Book as their property, but to make sure of no mistake he switched me through to Mr Falk of Furness, Withy & Co, Ld., who confirmed the ownership and stated that the "PROSPER" was not coming to this country at all, but was going to trade exclusively in the East in connection with the war efforts of the Allies in that region, and that it will be quite in order to record the Port of Registry as Hong Kong in this case as given by the Hong Kong Surveyor.
