Steamer "AGHIOS NICHOLAOS"

I am in receipt of your report No.8433 in respect of the Special Survey of this ship, and think it well to point out that a Special Survey (D) should have been carried out at this time.

If the shell plating has been drill tested, I shall be glad if you will furnish particulars of the plate thicknesses on a Rpt.8 (Dr.) by return, but if the plating has not been drilled I shall be glad if you will ascertain and let me know what arrangements are proposed in this respect.

As regards the machinery, please furnish First Entry Reports on Forms 4b and 13, and confirm that the fire extinguishing arrangements are in accordance with the Rules.

In connection with the installation of the new machinery, modifications to the pumping arrangements etc. were inevitable, and a plan showing the alterations should be furnished. Please also confirm that all alterations were carried out in accordance with the Rules.
