In May, 1954, the vessel was reported to have been sold to
Canadian Buyers and on the 2nd August this was confirmed, the new Owners
being Island Tug & Barge Ltd., of Vancouver B.C., who stated the vessel was
being taken to Vancouver to be converted to a dumb barge for the carriage
of logs, and plans were requested for conversion purposes.
No information having been received in this Office to the
effect that the work had been commenced enquiry was made, and the Vancouver
surveyors now state the ship is laid up at Victoria and that the Owners
have not yet decided for what service she will be utilized.
