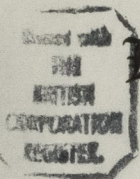

Dear Sir:-

We have been advised today by Mr. H.B. Elworthy,  
President of the Island Tug & Barge Ltd., Victoria, B. C. that  
they have bought the under-mentioned vessels:-

"ICOTEA" - "CARLOTA" - "CHEPITA" and "CONCHITA"

These vessels are presently being towed to Victoria  
where the "ICOTEA" is to be converted to a dumb barge, all the  
machinery being removed.

Mr. Elworthy intimated that he may require a Load  
line for this vessel.

With reference to the "CARLOTA", "CHEPITA" and  
"CONCHITA", it is understood that he proposes to convert these  
vessels either now or eventually to self-trimming log barges.

We are enclosing herewith copies of Mr. Elworthy's  
letters dealing with the "ICOTEA" and the "CARLOTA", "CHEPITA"  
and "CONCHITA" for your information. You will note that Mr.  
Elworthy has requested a complete set of plans for the "ICOTEA"  
and we wonder if arrangements could be made to obtain these for  
him.
