VESSEL'S NAME 'ALASKA PRINCE' REPORT Vcr. No. 7993

The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

This vessel is classed BS* (Coasting Service).

The Special Survey Type 4 due 11.48 was commenced 4.49 and advanced 8.49 Vcr.

To complete the Special Survey the oil fuel bunkers, oil fuel tank, after chain locker, port and starboard side tanks, fore peak and engine and boiler room D.B. tanks to be examined.

The VANCOUVER Surveyors now report (12.49), the vessel afloat, the above Special Survey completed and minor repairs effected.

The Owners propose docking the vessel in April or May next for Annual Survey due 4.50.

IT IS SUBMITTED the vessel is eligible to remain as classed by the British Corporation, and to have the Notation of 'ss. Vcr. 4.49' assigned as recommended.
