I shall be glad if you will ascertain and let me know what arrangements are proposed in regard to a further survey of the vessel's Refrigerating Installation.

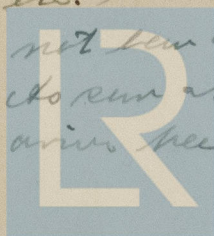
I would add that the vessel's R.M.C. Class is subject to a spare shunt field coil for the air circulating fan being supplied.
