Dear Sirs,

With reference to your RMC Report No.6613 on the motorship "VATNAJOKULL", it is observed that you have recommended a notation of @Lloyd's RMC 8,47. for frozen cargo in this case, and an interim certificate has been issued to this effect.

It is appreciated that this was done in accordance with the instructions contained in W.Dept. letter of the 22nd July, 1946, but before confirming such a restricted notation, which is an innovation, the Classing Committee would be glad to learn the nature of the frozen cargo likely to be carried, together with its normal range of temperature if possible.

It is proposed to resubmit the case to the Classing Committee on Friday next, and I shall be glad if you will endeavour to arrange for the necessary information to be sent here by that date.
