On being informed by Owners that the vessel was at a port near here a visit was paid by car, the only means of conveyance, and have to state as follows, in reply to your queries:-

The Oil fuel valves and pumps have not been made controllable from deck. This item was requested by the Director to be complied with by repairers at the last docking, to be prepared and fitted on the vessel's return.

Electrical fuses are of an approved type.

The 2" inch dia. branch bilge pipe has not been fitted in the Engine Room. If you would let me have particulars of this suction the information will be sent to Owners and the item noted for compliance, at the first opportunity.
