Dear Mr. Scott,

Many thanks for your letter of the 17th instant, respecting the motorships "TIO PEPE" and "EXPLORADOR IRADIER" from which I note and appreciate your difficulties.

In principle, however, in order to ensure smooth working throughout the system, I must deprecate the practice, without exception, of withholding reports under any pretext, when the vessel concerned has proceeded elsewhere.

As regards the "EXPLORADOR IRADIER", I hope that your reminder to Mr. Larrucea will have the desired effect, and that the report will consequently reach this Office in the near future.

Looking forward to the pleasure of seeing you in London next month, when we can discuss the complexities peculiar to Spain, and with kindest regards,
