I duly received your letter of the 29th March, with enclosures, relating to the above, and confirm my cable reply to you on the 14th instant as follows:-

'EASTERN AND NELLORE YOUR LETTER 29TH MARCH REFRIGERATING INSTALLATION STEEL PLAN APPROVED STOP NOTATION REGISTER BOOK AMENDED QUOTE SIX DIVISIONAL WT BULKHEADS IN UPPER TWEEN DECKS UNQUOTE ACCESS TO FANS AND MOTORS TO BE AS PER RULES STOP LETTER AND PLANS FOLLOWING AIRMAIL'

The machinery specification and plans, as detailed in your letter, will be approved provided the arrangements be as shown in the specification and as amended on the plans, and the remaining requirements of the Rules for Refrigerating Machinery and Appliances be complied with so far as they are applicable.

It is noted that other plans will be submitted in due course, and these should include "Arrangement of Refrigerating Machinery" and "Arrangement of Thermometers".

It is concluded that only 1.8 HP and 2.5 HP fan motors will be installed in No. 5 upper tween decks, but this should be confirmed.

I shall be glad if you will collect the cost of my cablegram viz. £1.0.0. and credit this amount to the London Office.


