In reply to the queries contained in your letter of the 28th ultimo I beg to report as follows:-

1. the thickness of the floors in the boiler room has been stated erroneously as 10 mm.; this should have been 12,5 mm. as approved;
2. the forecastle has been reported "open", as no end bulkhead is existing and fair lead openings are fitted in the shell in way. The length on deck is 21';
3. 4 steel wire ropes, 6 x 12, of 135 M. length each, 70 mm. circ., are supplied on board;
4. the inner surfaces of the bottom have not been coated and the bottom in way of the open floors clear of the engine space will require to be examined internally annually;
5. the lengths of the tanks, in British units, are as follows:-

Double bottom tank under bunkers 19.2'

Fore peak tank 9.4'

After peak tank 13.8'

Deep tank aft 13.1'

Deep tank forward 10.5'

Fresh water tank 3.9'

Waste water tank 10.5'
